Workforce and Adult Technical Education Payment and Refund Policy

Payment: Students are responsible for payment in-full by no later than the beginning of the first session that the class meets. Payment vouchers from your employer or financial aid award letters from other third-party payers such as VSAC, WIOA, or HireAbility may be used to register for any class. Personal checks, cash, credit cards are accepted. Payment plans are also available with half of tuition due by the first class meeting.

Tuition Deposit: All in-person programs require a \$100 tuition deposit to reserve a seat. Cash, check, or credit card are accepted. Students who receive a full tuition scholarship are entitled to a full refund of the deposit upon enrollment.

Refund Policy: Students will be given a full refund if the course for which you registered is cancelled by Southwest Tech for any reason or if the student withdraws from the course prior to the first class meeting. For withdrawals within the first week of class meetings, students may be entitled to a 50% refund at the discretion of the Workforce and Adult Technical Education Coordinator after a review of the circumstances. After the first week, no refund will be provided.

Online courses through Penn Foster offer a full refund within 6 days of enrollment. After this 6 day period, no refund will be offered.
