Meeting was opened by Leon Johnson, past committee chairperson at 3:07PM. He welcomed all and asked for additions to the agenda. Supt. Lawler suggested policies # 5080, #6141C, #7300 be added for discussion under "other." Johnson added that he would like policies #2600C and 3216C be discussed. #7100 was also suggested for discussion. John Lamson, our new Pre-Law Instructor, entered the room at 3:10PM, so Johnson led the introduction of those present. Johnson went on to explain the information received at the recent Lake Morey Vermont School Boards Association meeting concerning open meeting laws. Our board had three members present at this meeting, Johnson, Kelly and Haytko. Several presentations related directly to CTE and that information was shared with the committee. Johnson noted MAUMS included information concerning college bound students and their lack of ability to access CTE information in high school and how that affects their progress in life should college not work out so well for them.

The committee then began a discussion of election of a chairperson for this year, dates and times for meetings and topics for consideration in the coming year. The committee agreed that Johnson would continue as chair as much as he could due to time constraints. John Lamson added that he would be willing to assist with any policy needs and would be happy to learn more about the policy committee's duties and meeting process. Johnson noted the connection between the RGB full board, policy committee and CDC administration. He shared how the process should work when all are in sync. Johnson has been involved and leading this committee for a very long time and hopes to see some participation from other interested parties.
